

G20 Statement: a coalition of 20 opposition political parties in favour of Paul BIYA's candidacy.

Leaders of the G20 opposition parties met and issued the following statement:

- After two weeks of campaign in the country's 10 regions and Cameroon's diplomatic missions abroad;
- After listening to the voices of Cameroon's 360 subdivisions;
- After analysing the country's political, economic, security and social situation;
- Considering the unpreparedness of opposition candidates to assume the supreme state office;
- Taking into account the unambiguous egoism and narrow-mindedness of some presidential election candidates;
- Cognizant of the false promises made to Cameroonians by opposition candidates with very little experience in public administration;
- In order to preserve the nation's achievements: peace, stability, economic prosperity, national unity and living-together;
- Considering President Paul BIYA's powerful speech during his memorable October 7 rally in Maroua, which, to us, is a true message of hope, expectations and action;

We, presidents of the G20 political parties coalition, have unanimously decided to give our unflinching support to the candidacy of His Excellency Paul BIYA, who remains the best guarantor of stability, republican institutions and prosperity in Cameroon.

As we lend our unwavering support to the Head of State, His Excellency Paul BIYA, we propose four (4) actions, which we believe will address the main grievances we have garnered from our people in the ten regions.

- Form a mission-driven government of loyal individuals who will truly work in the interest of Cameroonians;
- Genuinely tackle the problem of water and electricity shortages (load shedding) in some regions of the country;
- Fast track effective work on the Mora-Dabanga-Kousseri, Garoua-Ngaoundéré, Ebolowa-Akom-II-Kribi and Bafoussam-Bafang-Nkongsamba-Douala roads, and continue work on the Ring Road in the North-West Region;
- Scrutinise the possibility of changing the Constitution in order to make provision for succession at the helm of the State that does not necessarily warrant the organisation of elections, which are subject to manipulation over the social media.

Furthermore, G20 condemns any initiative by some opposition candidates to self-proclaim themselves as winner of the presidential election through the use of illegal applications;

G20 urges all presidential election candidates to show proof of maturity and responsibility by waiting for the proclamation of results by the competent bodies authorised to do so by the regulations in force.

In the light of the international context, Cameroon cannot take the risks of accepting that an adventurer or adventurers to accede to the supreme magistracy of our country.


















